

2_There's not a perception of the connection between the various stages of waste management from collection to transportation to disposal.


3_Before throw the things, the people don't think to reuse waste, which are considered as something to be eliminated, even if they have often the potential for the creation of new products.

How to solve the problem of waste and involve the people of Nurra?


An economic and productive system can be developed from what we now consider waste, with the aim of involving citizens and improve the economy of the territory of Nurra
